

Bowls Victoria Board Elected

Board Election Results

Under the Bowls Victoria Constitution, **Rule 16 Board** and **Rule 17 Election of Elected Directors**, the election of the eight (8) **Elected Directors** to the first Board of Bowls Victoria was concluded with the counting of votes on Friday 30 April 2010.

The count was conducted by myself as Returning Officer, supported by independent tallying officials from Lander & Rogers and from Nicholas/Miller/Meehans and witnessed by seven Scrutineers appointed by their individual Candidates.

In all, 483 Clubs of (91% of the 532 Clubs) submitted ballots. 3,848 votes were counted; two ballots (16 votes) were judged as informal. Fourteen (14) Metropolitan Clubs and thirty-five (35) Country Clubs did not lodge ballots.

Rules 16.3 (d) states that:

The first election of Elected Directors after the establishment of the Association (Bowls Victoria) shall, subject to this Constitution, elect four male and four female Elected Directors. The terms of such Elected Directors shall be determined as follows:

- (ii) of the male candidates, the two that receive the most votes shall serve a two-year term, the other two shall serve a one-year term;***
- (ii) of the female candidates, the two that receive the most votes shall serve a two-year term, the other two shall serve a one-year term;***

I therefore declare that:

The two male Elected Directors to serve for two years are Graeme Hosken and John Fisher.
The two female Elected Directors to serve for two years are Betty Collins and Maureen Connolly.

The two male Elected Directors to serve for one year are Murray Rowe and Barrie Close.
The two female Elected Directors to serve for one year are Rosemary Varty and Pat Calabresi.
