Each year the Integrated Pairs Tournament and the Multi-Disabilities Championships are run, showcasing the best bowlers with a disability from around Victoria.

There are also Victorian State squads for bowlers with an intellectual disability, bowlers with a physical disability, **Deaf Bowls Victoria and Blind Bowls Victoria who compete at national level**. There is also a pathway to represent **Australia at the Commonwealth Games**.
