Any player, coach, official, volunteer, staff, contractor or visitor during a Bowls Victoria governed event are not permitted to smoke within the grounds of the bowling Club or within 10 metres of the perimeter of the Club. Please see the Conditions of Play for further information.

Conditions of Play

1. The Champion of State Pennant is conducted in accordance with:
 - Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 3rd Edition and BA Domestic Regulations January 2015
 - Bowls Australia Policies and
 - Bowls Victoria Constitution, BV Regulations and BV Policies
2. **Event Eligibility** – Separate Champions for both Saturday & Midweek Pennant will be contested between the winners of Region Division 1 Pennant and winner of Metropolitan Midweek Pennant Elimination Play-off & Saturday Premier Division winner.

An eligible member is one who had played at least four Pennant games with the club during the season in the respective Competition.

Clubs which have two or more sides in a Divisions top Pennant competition and are successful with one side winning their Region Final shall be permitted to choose its side from all eligible affiliated members.

3. **Side Format** - Sides must contest the Championships in accordance with the Conditions of Play in place when they qualified at Regional Final level.
4. **Side Selection** - Each Region will nominate up to 14 players from which three teams of four will be selected for each game. Should there be a change in the composition or playing position of the intended teams for any game the Tournament Director must be advised prior to the commencement of the game. A Side Manager is not permitted to play unless they are also listed as an emergency.
5. **Format of Play** - Play will be conducted in Two Sections of Six Regions determined by an open draw.

All Section Round matches will be of 15 ends per rink, with a time limit of 2.5 hours (150 min).

If the Jack is made dead after notification that time has expired it will be re-spotted on the centre line at the 2 metre mark and play will continue until the end is completed.

The two Section winners will play a knockout final to determine the Champion of State Pennant.

The Final will be of 18 ends per rink (No time limit) or as otherwise determined by the Controlling Body.



- 6. Trial Ends** - One trial end in each direction is permitted prior to the start of the first Section round ONLY on each day of play.
- 7. Timing of Games** - Play will not begin until notification is given, and the finish of the game will also be given in the same manner by whatever means are at the disposal of the Controlling Body.
- Any Team not ready to commence play at the scheduled starting time shall, on appeal to the Umpire by the opposing team, have the first end awarded against them and be penalised 8 shots
- 8. Scoring** - Sectional Scoring: 3 points for each round won & 1 point for each round tied.

Section winners will be determined in accordance with Law 27.

Additional Event Information

Smoke Free Policy - Whether they are acting in an official BV capacity or not, any player, coach, official, volunteer, staff, contractor or visitor during a BV governed event are not permitted to smoke within the grounds of the bowling Club or within 10 metres of the perimeter of the Club.

Any player, coach or official that continues to breach the Smoke Free Policy may face penalties as set down by the BV Disciplinary Committee.

Alcohol - The consumption of alcohol on the green by a player whilst a game is in progress is not permitted.

Mobile Phones - The use of mobile phones on the green by a player is not permitted.

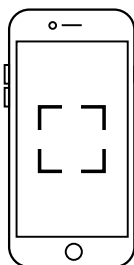
