

Greens Inspection Guidelines



NEW GREEN – Requires BV Greens Committee Inspection

Means construction of a green at a site where a green has not previously existed. This includes **NEW**:

- drains,
- base,
- ditches,
- plinths,
- banks and surrounds,
- natural or synthetic surface.

RECONSTRUCTED, CONVERTED & RESURFACED GREENS – Requires BV Greens Committee Inspection

Means alterations to any of the following:

- drains,
- base,
- ditches,
- plinths,
- banks and surrounds.
- Conversion from Natural surface to a Synthetic surface
- Conversion from Synthetic surface to a Natural surface
- Conversion to a different type of Synthetic surface
- Conversion to a different type of Natural surface
- Replacement of a Synthetic surface
- Rolling back a Synthetic surface
- Re-stitching a Synthetic surface

REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE – DO NOT Require BV Greens Committee Inspection

Means alterations to any of the following:

- Removal of excess filling from ditches
- Repair of Banks covering material
- Top dressing
- Coring
- Resewing of bare patches
- Vacuuming/Sweeping of Synthetic surfaces
- Scarifying
