Conditions of play

All matches will be played in accordance with the

Laws of the Sport of Bowls-Crystal Mark 3rd Edition January 2015

- CONTROLLING BODY:** Bowls Victoria
- EVENT:** U18 Interstate Test Series against South Australia
- DATES:** Tuesday 8th, Wednesday 9th & Thursday 10th of January 2019
- STARTING TIMES:** The commencement time for each match will be determined by Bowls Victoria.
- VENUE:** City of Geelong BC (Sommers St, Belmont VIC 3216)
- ENTRY CONDITIONS:** Each State participating will select a team of five bowlers from their affiliated members to attend the Test Series. Only bowlers who are affiliated may participate in the event. Each bowler must be under 18 of age as of the first day of the event.
- SUBSTITUTES:** If a substitute is needed during the course of a match the substitute shall be chosen from the reserves of that side or, if no reserves, a nominee may act as a substitute. The substitute must be affiliated with the state chosen to play for and must be eligible under the age criteria.
- STRUCTURE:** Each side will consist of five players. Each of the five players will play in an assortment of the four disciplines. The personnel of each team may be altered for any match prior to the commencement of play.
- FORMAT:**
- Singles: All matches are 4 bowl singles with the first player to score 21.
 - Pairs: All matches are 3 bowl pairs of 18 ends duration.
 - Triples: All matches are 2 bowl triples of 18 ends duration.
 - Fours: All matches are 2 bowl fours of 15 ends duration.
- The series will consist of three tests; each test will consist of two sessions, with the first session consisting of pairs and triples followed by the second session consisting of fours and singles.
- TRIAL ENDS:** One trial end in each direction will be permitted immediately prior to the commencement of play and prior to the start of subsequent matches.

SCORING: At the completion of each Test, the winner of each Test will be decided by the total number of points accumulated from each discipline.

2 points will be awarded for a win in each discipline.

1 point will be awarded for a tie in each discipline.

(A tied match remains a tie)

The team that accumulates the highest number of points will win the test.

In the event of points being the same for each side, the winner shall be decided upon accumulated shots up over the four disciplines.

In the event of shots up being level, the test shall be declared a draw.

DETERMINATION OF THE WINNER:

Perpetual Shields (if available) will be awarded to the side winning the highest number of Tests.

If each side wins and draws an equal amount of Tests, the Shield will be retained by the State that last won the Series.

FOOTWEAR AND ATTIRE:

The attire of all players and side mangers shall be in line with the National Dress Regulations as set out by Bowls Australia.

BOWLS DISCS:

All discs used by a side shall be the official state disc and must be on all bowls used for play.

OTHER LAWS, REGULATIONS & POLICIES:

The Test Series will be played in accordance with The Laws of The Sport of Bowls CM third edition.

All relevant Domestic Regulations & policies will apply. These include Smoking not being permitted on the green.

The Controlling Body has the right to alter the conditions of play if deemed necessary.
